Please complete a separate form for each child. Places are limited to one course per child.

The courses on offer are as follows:

Courses 1 – 4: Years 3-8 three full days
Strings: Violin / Viola / Cello / Double Bass

Brass: Trumpet / Tenor Horn / Trombone / French Horn

Woodwind: Recorder / Clarinet / Flute / Saxophone / Bassoon / Oboe

**Acoustic Guitar** 

These courses are for children in years 3 - 8 each running for 3 full days. Children can sign up for only one of these instruments and **should be in receipt of regular tuition and have had lessons for at least one year.** They must bring their own instrument with them. In addition to instrumental music, children will be engaged in a variety of other activities including general musicianship, singing, creative music making and performance.

Courses 5 - 6: Years 3-8 three full days

Samba: Drumming and Carnival percussion

Steel Pans: (limited places)

These courses for children in years 3 - 8 are **open access**; therefore no previous experience is necessary. Children will also take part in general musicianship activities including singing and composing.

Course 7: three days, mornings only (Reception class not eligible)

Years 1 & 2 Creative Music- Making

This is an open access course for children in **years 1 and 2 only**. During the morning children will be involved in a range of activities including singing, composing, exploring sound, rhythm work and general music making activities. There will be a short performance of their work on the last morning of this course. ## Supplementary charges:

For Hackney residents whose children attend an out-of-borough school, there is an <u>additional £10.00 per</u> applicant added to each advertised course fee.

For applicants who neither live in the borough, nor attend a Hackney School, there is an additional £15.00 per applicant added to each advertised course fee. Concession rates do not apply.

## Registration:

Registration is from 09.30 – 10.00am each day.

## Collecting your child:

<u>Please be prompt at 3.30pm when collecting your child at the end of the day</u>, as there are no facilities for childcare.

If you are happy for your child to make the journey home unaccompanied, you must provide written permission clearly stating this. Alternatively, you can complete a parental permission slip on arrival at registration on the first day (permission slips available at registration).

Please ensure that your child has a packed lunch for each full day course and refreshments for the morning break. Children on the morning only course may require refreshments also.
